




Brown Clee C.E. Primary School

This survey was sent to all parents. There were 36 respondents. Each survey asked 12 questions (432 possible responses).



Additional Comments from Parents

- Our child has flourished since starting Brown Clee.

- I do not like/agree with being charged for swimming or when children go on sporting activities.
- As a parent we are not kept informed of anything concerning my child.

- Request for maths session for parents

Actions

- We will be holding 2 parent sessions in the Autumn Term: one for Phonics/Reading and one for Maths – keep an eye out for information.
- We will continue to promote being an open and approachable school, where all staff are willing to listen and respond to parental concerns or queries. Please do contact us if you have any concerns regarding school or your child, as without being made aware of potential issues we are unable to respond and deal with them.
- We currently hold 2 parent evenings (Autumn/Summer), and publish an annual written report in the Spring Term. Our doors are always open for any parent with concerns about their child's progress. We also share as much information on events in school or class on the school website, our Facebook page and on our Twitter feed. We will investigate whether there are any options for sharing pupils progress data on a manageable, more frequent basis.
- Sadly, with current school funding streams, we do need to ask for voluntary contributions, in-line with our Charging and Remissions Policy. We believe that trips and sporting events are an important part of school life, and without parental contributions these events would not be able to occur. Please be assured that school also does contribute to the costs.
