

Hygiene Procedures

1. Anyone with symptoms of Covid19, or living with someone who has symptoms of Covid19 does not come to school, and self isolates as per the guidance.
2. Children and staff are to sanitise their hands on arrival in school.
3. Children and staff to ensure they use effective handwashing method for 20 seconds.
4. Children and staff sanitise hands each time they **enter** the classroom.
5. Children and staff use 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it' approach to coughs and sneezes.
6. Children to be taught importance of good hygiene, and why not to touch their mouth, eyes and nose (face).
7. Tissues put in separate tissue bin, which is emptied twice a day (end lunchtimes by TAs, and cleaners at end of day).
8. Tables and regularly touched surfaces to be cleaned regularly in class by teacher.
9. Staff toilet door handles to be cleaned by staff after use.
10. Rooms are to have at least one window open at all times.
11. Doors are to be propped open to minimise contact.
12. Equipment that is frequently used, eg pencils, scissors etc, should not be shared, and children and staff should have their own.
13. Classroom resources such as books and games can be used and shared within a bubble but cleaned regularly.
14. Each class to have its' own playtime equipment, and PE equipment.
15. Each class to have its' own antibacterial spray and disposable cloths, its' own hand gel, tissue paper and a tissue bin. If stocks start to get low, teacher to let Admin know so we can ensure stocks are maintained.
