★ English/Phonics/Reading:

★ This week we are continuing work based on the book 'Harry's Home.'

★ Y1's will be finishing writing the story in their own words and editing and improving their writing.

★ Reception are focussing on what Harry saw on his journey using the sentence starter:

★ 'I can see a ' They are also creating artwork and writing labels for the class display.

★ Ideas to support learning:

- ★ • Daily reading – even if it is only a page a night!
- ★ • Draw all the things you might see on a journey (real or imaginary). Use the sentence starter ' I can see

★ Phonics:

★ Reception have been continuing to learn the alphabet and sounds qu and sh.

★ Tricky words: he, she and we.

★ Year ones have been learning alternative pronunciations for graphemes g, c, and u.

★ Tricky words: when, what and out.



★ Maths:

★ This week Y1's are using their prior knowledge of part, part whole to find the missing number in number sentences. Reception are subtracting 2 single digit numbers and counting back to find the answer.

★ Ideas to support their learning:

- ★ • Reception– Practise counting to 20 (and beyond) forwards **and backwards**.
- ★ • Y1's - Give your child verbal word problems (within 10) - For example, There are five of us in the room, I go out how many are left? I have ten sweets and I give you 2 sweets how many do I have left? Do it at any opportunity, in the car on a walk etc.
- ★ • Y1's and reception– I can see many of you have been practising number formation– Well done! 2 and 5 are still difficult for some of us, so keep practising these!



★ Topic Work: RE - The Church as a sensational structure. Computing/Beebot

★ This week we are finishing learning about the Church. We are planning and designing our own stained glass windows. Reception are also beginning to look at programming. Y1's are learning how to use the school computers.
