

Week Beginning: 18th June 2018

This week your child's learning has focussed around the following areas. English/Phonics/Reading:

This week we have been continuing our work based around our class book 'Sharing a Shell.' We have been identifying adjectives in the book and using real shells to help us think of our own adjectives to describe a shell. We will also be making puppets and using them to retell the story.

Ideas to support learning:

- Daily reading – even if it is only a page a night!
- Make a puppet based on the class book or a book of your choice - can you retell the story to the class?

Phonics:

Reception have been revising all sounds learnt so far

Tricky words - looked, Mr, Mrs, so, asked.

Maths:

This week year ones have been revisiting addition and subtraction, looking at numbers up to 20.

Reception have been ordering shells, twigs and themselves, using the language bigger, smaller, taller, longer and shorter.

Suggestions to support learning at home:

- Practise addition and subtraction statements using numbers up to 20.
- Order items from home according to size– which is the biggest? Smallest? Tallest? Shortest? Longest?

Topic Work: Science - melting and freezing.

This week we have been learning about melting and freezing. We have been making ice cubes and conducting an experiment to understand that ice melts at different rates in different places. We have also enjoyed making (and eating) ice lollies.

- Make ice lollies at home - observe the freezing and melting process.
- Melt chocolate and observe the changes from solid to liquid.
