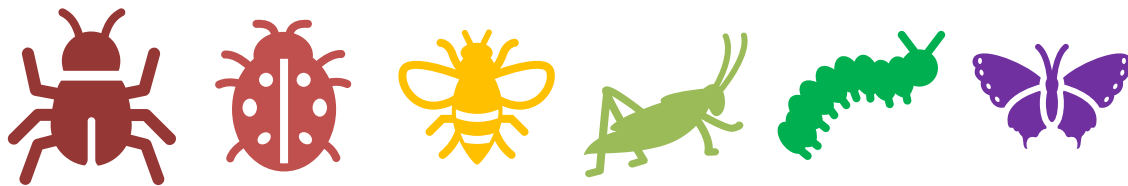




Mini-Beast Madness



During the spring term our work across the curriculum will be linked to the theme of mini-beasts.

ENGLISH


Our class texts this term will be 'The Very Lonely Firefly,' and 'The Quiet Cricket.' We will make predictions, discuss character and plot and write our own stories about a mini-beast. In the second half of the term, non-fiction work will be based on the life-cycle of a butterfly. We will also be writing and performing Spring poetry. Handwriting will be taught in phonics and discretely during afternoon sessions.

MATHS

In maths we will be covering place value, multiplication & division, fractions, length and height, weight and volume.

TOPIC- (Subjects are blocked into weeks.)

This term, our science work will be learning about the life cycle of a butterfly and identifying common plants and the parts of a flower. In history we will be learning about Charles Darwin. Our RE work will be learning about the Christian story of creation. PHSE worked is linked with how we can care for the world. We will also be designing and creating our own vegetarian pizza's in design and technology. Art work will be based about Vincent Van Gogh. In music, we will be learning songs based on Mini-Beast Madness. P.E. sessions will be dance and movement and running and relays.
