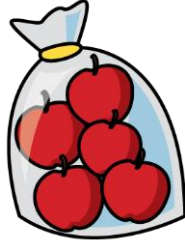
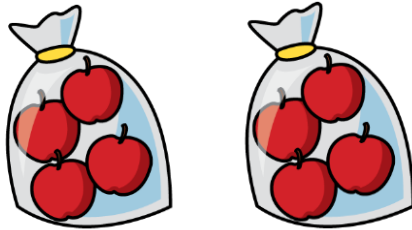

Annie has two jugs of juice.

- There are 14 litres of juice in jug A.
- Annie pours 3 litres of juice from jug A into jug B.
- There is now the same amount of juice in each jug.

How many litres of juice were in the jug at the start?

A shop sells roses.

- $\frac{2}{7}$ of the roses are red.
- The rest are white roses.
- There are 30 red roses.

How many more white roses are there than red roses?

There are 3 groups of children.

- There are the same number of children in 1st and 2nd group.
- There are 75 more children in the 3rd group than the 1st group.
- Some children are moved from the 3rd group to the other groups.
- There are now the same number in each group.
- There are 193 children in the 1st group now.

How many children were in the 1st group at the start?
