<i>appearance fees and royalties</i>	Appearance fees are payments for turning up for something Royalties are payments for using someone else's property
<i>Our Herc had cash to burn</i>	Hercules had loads of money
<i>nouveau riche</i>	Means "newly rich"
<i>He could tell you what the Grecian earn</i>	This a play on words: A "Greek pot" is called a Grecian Urn.
<i>an awesome 10for10</i>	Hercules was perfect
<i>He sees, he conquers</i>	He can achieve whatever he wants to
<i>moxie brains and spunk</i>	Moxie brains and spunk both refer to being brave or courageous
<i>who'da thunk</i>	Who would have though?
<i>glad in gladiator</i>	He's great at being a gladiator (someone trained to fight in an arena)
<i>Whose daring deeds are great theater?</i>	Whose actions are very interesting to watch?
<i>Is he bold?</i>	Is he brave?
<i>Our favourite flavour</i>	He's popular right now
<i>Riding high</i>	He's successful at the moment
<i>not conceited</i>	Conceited describes someone who has a high opinion of themselves, so this means Hercules is not arrogant.
