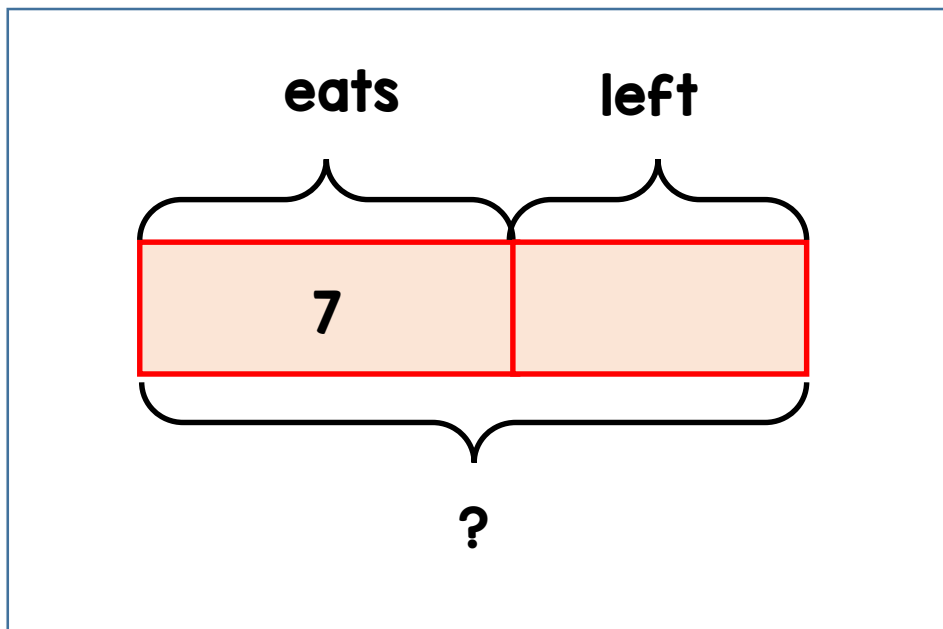
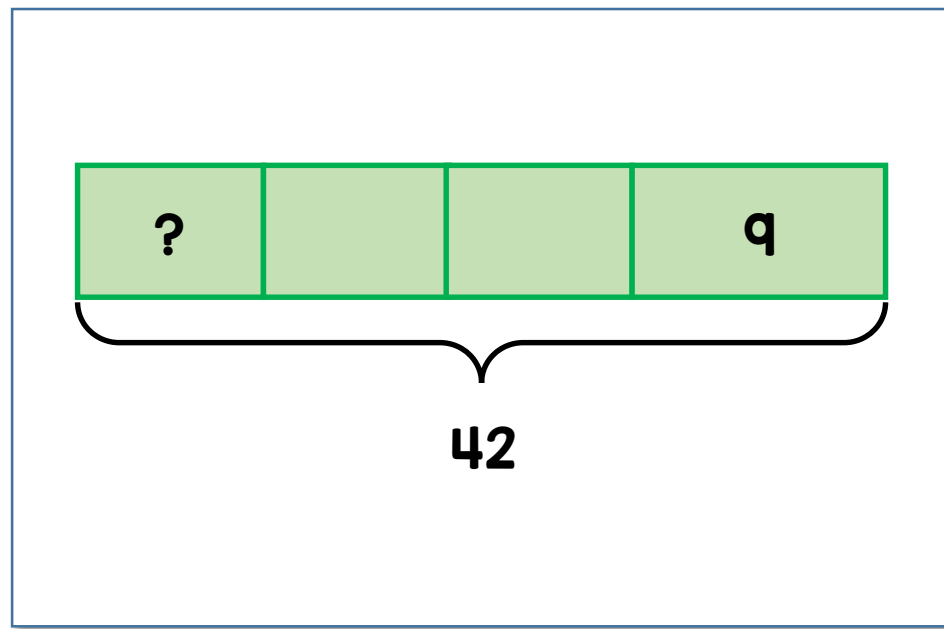


1 Ron has a bag of grapes.

 How many grapes were in the bag at the start?



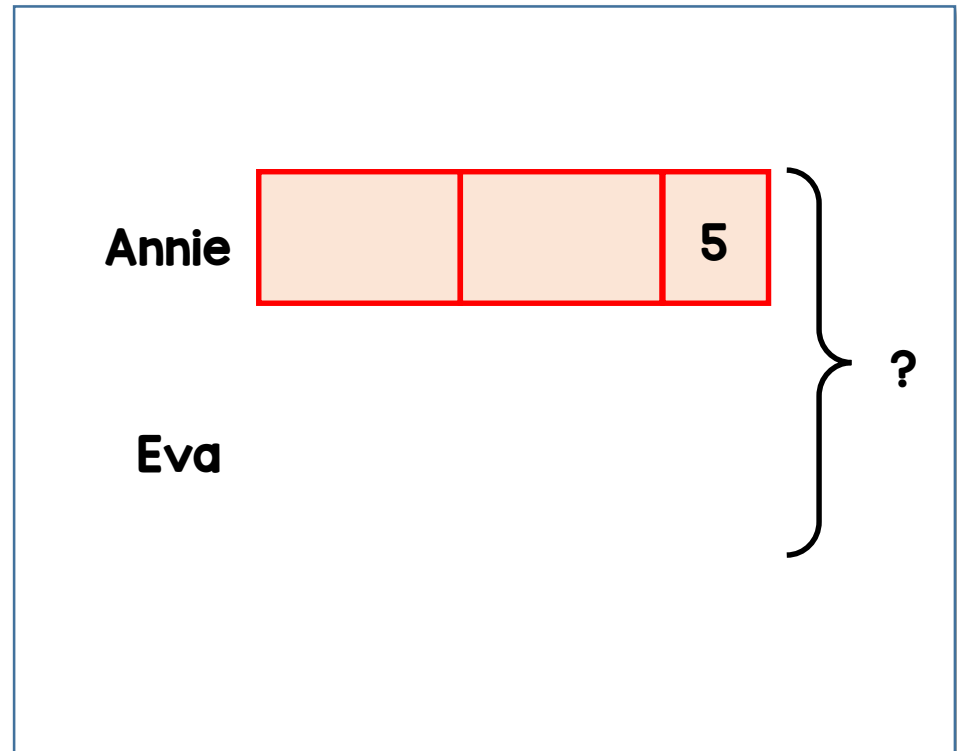
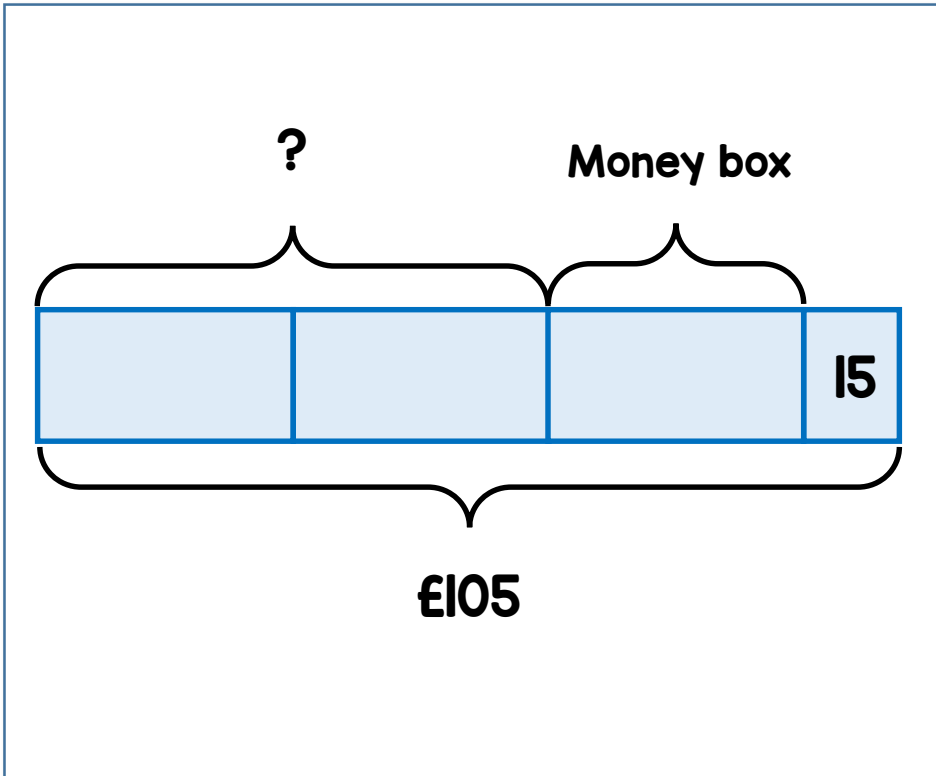
2 Mo has 42 sweets.
