

# Autumn Term — Grasshoppers Superheroes!



In Science, we are exploring the human body. Naming different parts of our bodies, what do we need to eat to keep our bodies healthy, the importance of exercise and the impact it has and how to keep ourselves hygienic. We will also look at the babies of different animals and how they grow into adults.

## English


In English, we will be exploring different versions of 'The Three Little Pigs', including the book 'The Three Little 'Superpigs' by Claire Evans'. We will also do work on the 'Supertato' series. The children will be designing their own superhero and alter ego and writing stories about their missions. We will be also reading 'Charlie's Superhero Underpants' by Paul Bright and using this as inspiration for writing their own round the world adventure.



We will be exploring writing poetry based on the poem, 'If I was A Superhero' by Daniel Hooks. The children will continue to have a 20 minute phonics session four times a week and daily spelling and handwriting practice.

### Maths

In Maths, the children will be starting off their maths work with Place Value. We will then work on Addition & Subtraction, Shape and Money, this term. The children will be learning how to use the maths resources and learning new strategies to support their calculations.



#### Art

In Art, we will be looking at the work of Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein. We will explore what 'pop art' is and compare the work of these artists The children will use these techniques to create their own pop art based on portraits and everyday objects.



#### RE

In RE, we will be reading some of 'The Parables of Jesus', including the Lost Son, and the Good Samaritan. We will discuss and think about what we can learn from these stories and how we can apply the teachings to our own lives. We will think about the four main types of prayer and write our own prayers.



# <u>History & Geography</u>

In History, we will be exploring the life of Grace Darling. How did she become famous? What did she achieve?

In Geography, the children will name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans and learn about significant landmarks within these continents. This knowledge will be used in their Superhero story writing.





#### PE

In Dance, the children will explore how a superhero would move and use their body. We will use these moves to create a Superhero dance. They will also learn two Superhero dances; 'Let's Go Heroes' and 'We Are Superheroes'. In Games, the children will learn techniques for running and jumping. They will apply this to small team games and use simple tactics for attacking and defending.
